Every student studies one year each at two different European consortium partner universities.

Scholarship Scheme:

Erasmus Mundus scholarships will be available for intakes 2020 to 2023. Accepted students may also attend on a self financing basis.

The Internal Summer School will take place in late August each year for one week for all students.

For first year students the primary focus will be on joint induction: introduction of the administrative and organizational aspects of the LCT programme; intercultural training; experience exchange with second year students; study-related soft skills training, e.g., study and research methods, academic writing presentation skills teamwork time management






